

# Each Passport is made up of a series of targets...

To count to 50 - forwards and backwards

To count in twos

To count in fives

To count in tens

Know by heart all number bonds that make 10

Recall doubles of all numbers to 10

Mixed Test

# Each Passport is made up of a series of targets...

Know by heart all the squares of numbers between 1 and 12

Know by heart all squares of multiples of 10

Recognise and recall factors of numbers up to 100 and corresponding multiples

Know by heart tests of divisibility for multiples of 2,3,4,5,6,9 and 10
